

MONEY WEEK IN ALBANIA

2022







On 21-27 March 2022, the Bank of Albania, in cooperation with the Albanian Association of Banks, with the support of the Ministry of Education and Sport, and the Deposit Insurance Agency (DIA), launched Money Week 2022 under the theme "Build your future, be smart with your money!".

More than 2200 children from 150 elementary and high schools and more than 600 students from 10 universities.















On March 24, was held the opening ceremony of Money Week. The Governor of the Bank of Albania, the Minister of Education and Sport, and the Chairman of the Albanian Association of Banks, as well as other high executives from commercial banks, attended.

After the speeches, the event continued with the distribution of prizes for winners of the 4 contests, previously launched by BoA and AAB:

- Drawing contest for 3rd and 4th-grade. This contest was supported by Union Bank.
- Meme contest for 9th-grade students. This contest was supported by OTP Bank Albania.
- Best Video contest for high-school students. This contest was supported by Credins Bank.
- Challenge of the week: 7 questions on money and banks for high-school students. This contest was supported by Raiffeisen Bank.
- Best essay contest. This contest was supported by Banka Kombëtare Tregtare (BKT).

Money Quiz

On March 30, the Albanian Association of Banks (AAB), in cooperation with the Bank of Albania and the support of the Ministry of Education and Sport, and the Deposit Insurance Agency (ASD), organized for the fourth time the Money Quiz. This competition has become an annual tradition and aims at improving financial knowledge among children and youth.

The winning team is from "Hafiz Ali Podgorica" school in Durrës. This winning team will represent Albania for the fourth time in the finals of the European Money Quiz, which will take place online, on 10 May 2022.

360 children, between 13 and 15-year-old, from 58 9-year schools participated.
